Phase 1:
Language Acquisition (Grade 1-3)

Objectives: Develop basic speaking, listening, and early literacy skills through interactive engagement.

- **Follow** simple **spoken instructions**.
- **Participate** in **basic** conversations.
- **Listen** to and **understand** **short stories**, **descriptions**, and dialogues.
- **Understand** basic **sentence structure**.
- **Begin forming** simple sentences.
- **Read** and understand short or **early reader** books.

Phase 2:
Linguistic Acquisition (Grade 4-6)

Objectives: Strengthen fluency, comprehension, and writing skills for academic and daily communication.

- **Engage** in **longer conversations** (e.g. discussing hobbies, telling short stories).
- **Express** **opinion** and **ideas**.
- **Develop** **listening comprehension** for academic subjects.
- **Identify** **main ideas** and details in a paragraph.
- **Write** simple paragraphs.
- **Use** basic **grammar structures** correctly.
